

KENT MOUNTAIN CENTRE - DOS AND DON'TS

The following are explained on arrival by the member of staff who will greet you, if further clarification is required please speak to either your instructor or the Head of Centre.

1. It is the responsibility of visiting groups to help keep KMC clean and tidy. It is your home for the week, please leave it as you find it.
2. Personal possessions to be cleared off the bedroom floors in the morning and placed in storage areas provided.
3. Please report any damage immediately, preferably to the Head of Centre.
4. Students should use only the entrance from the courtyard, the main door is for staff and visitors.
5. No outside shoes or boots to be worn in the main house, they should be placed in the boot cupboards (Main House) or entrance lobby (Lodge) on arrival back at KMC. **Slippers only indoors**, no bare feet or wet socks.
6. Outdoor clothing to go in cloakroom if dry and in drying room if wet (please clean off any dirt first).
7. Food and drinks to be consumed in dining room areas only.
8. No smoking in KMC buildings or in the vehicles. No alcohol or drug abuse during the group's stay, any breach of this rule will be treated most seriously.
9. Gentle treatment of the building please. It is old, therefore please walk rather than run and do not jump off the bunks.
10. We discourage young people from bringing and using their own electrical equipment-in particular hair dryers and straighteners. If hair dryers are required they can be obtained from the staff room.
11. We discourage young people from bringing and using mobile phones as they distract from the experience we provide. Their use is not permitted by students during activity sessions.
12. Young people should not leave KMC grounds without their leader's permission.
13. No aerosols to be used (they set off the fire alarms).
14. No graffiti!
15. Any loss of KMC equipment or damage caused may incur an additional charge.
16. Visitors are to prepare their own flasks before 10.00 am and after returning from the day's outing they are asked to clean their own lunch box, leaving it in the washing up area.
